## Way of Life

Belt Meanings	
White	Signifies <i>innocence</i> , as that of a beginning student with no previous knowledge of CHAMPION KARATE.
Yellow	Signifies <i>Earth</i> , from which a plant sprouts and takes root as the CHAMPION KARATE foundation is being laid.
Orange	Signifies <i>growth</i> , where the CHAMPION KARATE foundation begins to take solid form.
Green	Signifies the <i>plant's growth</i> , as the CHAMPION KARATE skills begin to develop.
Blue	Signifies the <i>heavens</i> , towards which the plant mature into a towering tree as training in CHAMPION KARATE progresses.
Red	Signifies <i>danger</i> , cautioning the student to exercise control, and warning the opponent to stay away.
Black	Opposite of white, therefore signifying the maturity and proficiency of the CHAMPION KARATE style.

REMEMBER to always address the instructor as "Sir" or "Ma'am".
